SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WINNIPEG CITY CLERKS  
DEPARTMENT AND THE CANADIAN UNION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES LOCAL 500

ARTICLE 1 - PREAMBLE

- 1.01 It is understood and agreed between the parties that this agreement shall not vary or change in any respect the intent or meaning of the Collective Agreement currently in effect.
- 1.02 This agreement shall come into force and effect on the date of signing and shall continue in force and effect until December 31, 1997.
- 1.03 This agreement may be amended at any time by the mutual agreement of the parties, and shall remain in full force and effect during negotiations of any revisions or amendments, pursuant to Article 10 of the Collective Agreement.

ARTICLE 2 - SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

- 2.01 This Agreement covers all clerical staff, hired specifically for, and assigned to the Board of Revision, during the summer of 1997.

ARTICLE 3 - HOURS OF WORK


- 3.01 There shall be two (2) shifts for employees so assigned to the Board of Revision.
- (a) The first shift shall be from 0700 hours to 1500 hours, with a one (1) hour unpaid period for lunch, from Monday to Friday inclusive, for a total of seven(7) hours daily and thirty five (35) hours weekly;

(b) The second shift shall be from 1500 hours to 2300 hours, with a one (1) hour unpaid period for lunch, from Monday to Friday inclusive, for a total of seven(7) hours daily and thirty five (35) hours weekly.

3.02 Upon consultation with the Union, the daily hours of work (starting times and finishing times) may be varied by management where service requirements warrant.


