EPC Approves New Governance for Assiniboine Park

On June 13, the City's Executive Policy Committee approved a new governance structure for Assiniboine Park. The new governance structure will include the creation of an independent not-for-profit board to manage the Park including the fundraising, restoration and redevelopment of the overall Park and its amenities.

CUPE Local 500 has objected to this move and proposed a more viable option for the City. "We believe that the City should adopt a governance model that assures the Park remains a public service and asset," said Local 500 President Gary Swanson. "Our model involves City operations working with a new Winnipeg Parks Board. This structure would provide the most efficient operational support, funding potential, volunteer and community input."

The Governance issue will be on the agenda at the next meeting of City Council to be held on June 20 at 9:30 a.m.

The union will be making a presentation and encourages as many members as possible to be present in the gallery during the meeting.
